Despite treatment the tumour has tripled in size. Her family have been advised that she needs treatment that is immediately available in the USA. Although she could receive the same treatment on the NHS, protocol means that funding/paperwork takes at least 8 weeks to produce and time is not on the family's side. The family need to raise £160,000 in the next few weeks. **The family have asked if the school could help, so we have decided that whatever you contribute tomorrow will be split equally between Children in Need and Frankie Rose's fund.**
