Busy week:

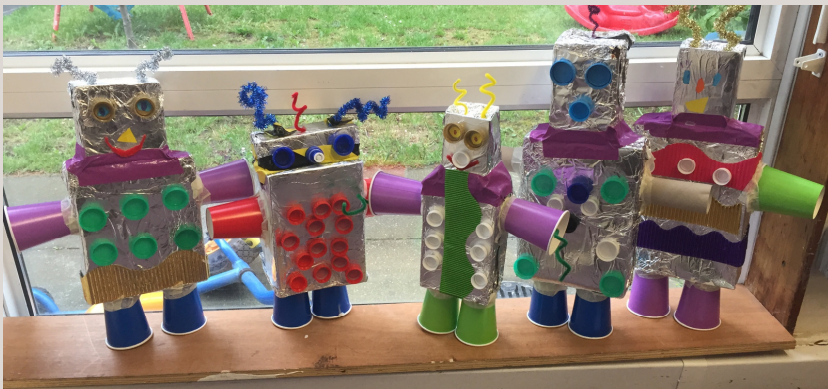
