**London Bridge attacks:**

We were all horrified by the events of last weekend and as a school we have been very closely monitoring children for any signs of distress about what happened. Our assembly theme this week, which had been planned months ago was British Values and we held a minute's silence on Tuesday (which includes all the children at Wick Court). Better Bankside inform us of the following:

- Borough Market will not be opening this weekend.
- If you would like to leave a floral tribute, the official location is currently outside The Barrowboy and Banker on London Bridge.
- The Samaritans have offered to support anyone affected by the events. Volunteers are at London Bridge station lower concourse today until 7pm.
