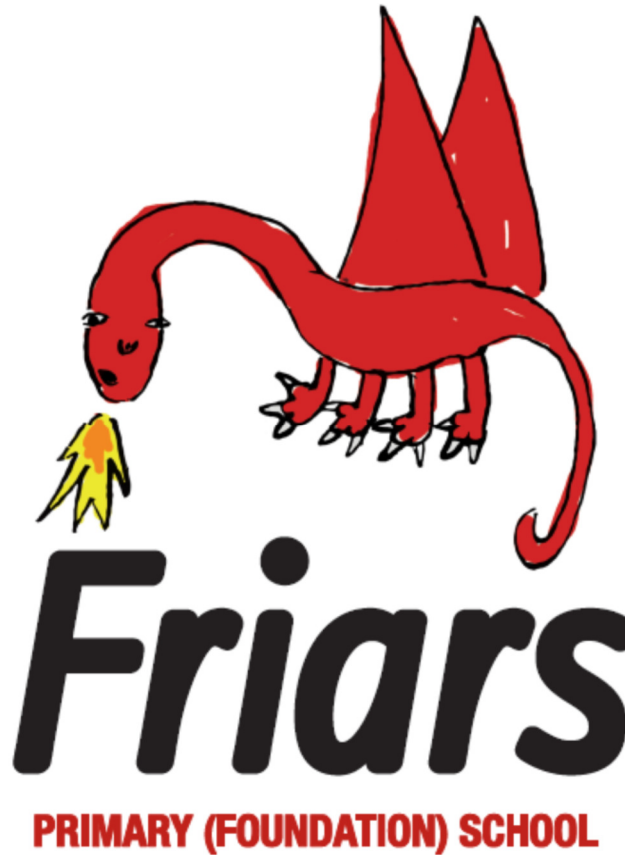
### The Year 3 Team
