I hope you have all had a lovely half term.

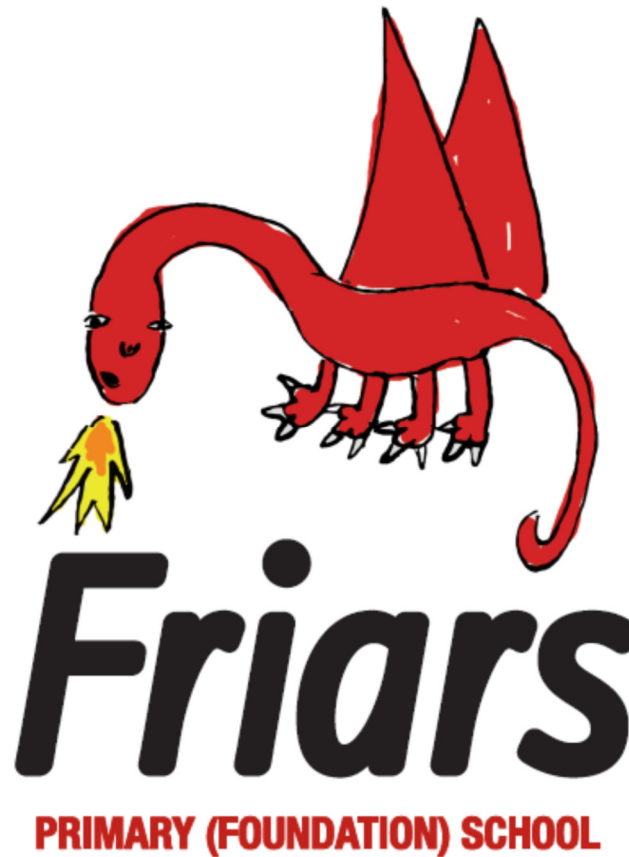
This half term, Year 4's CLJ topic is,

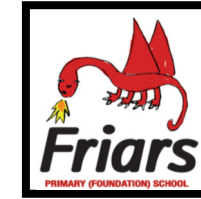
