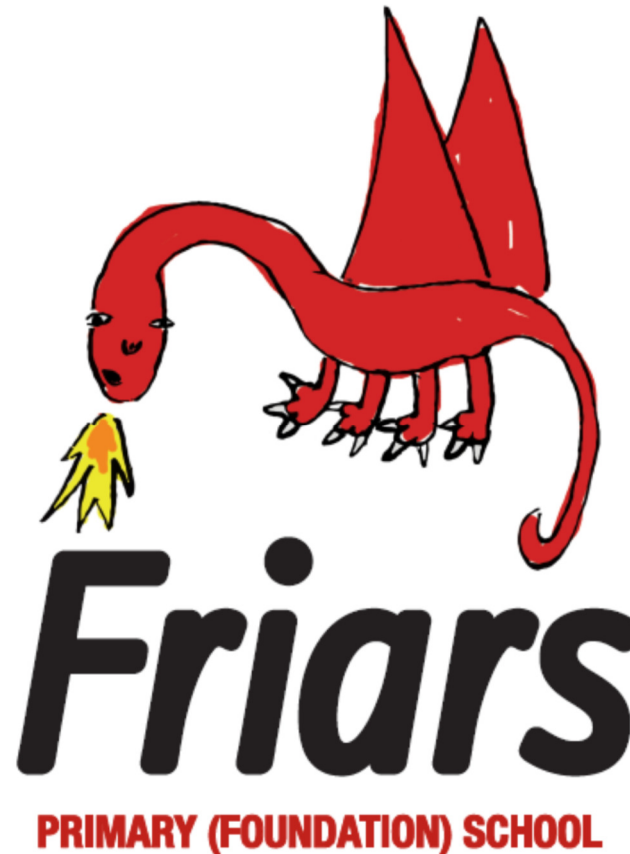
Reading
