November 29th—Y3 1:30—6:30

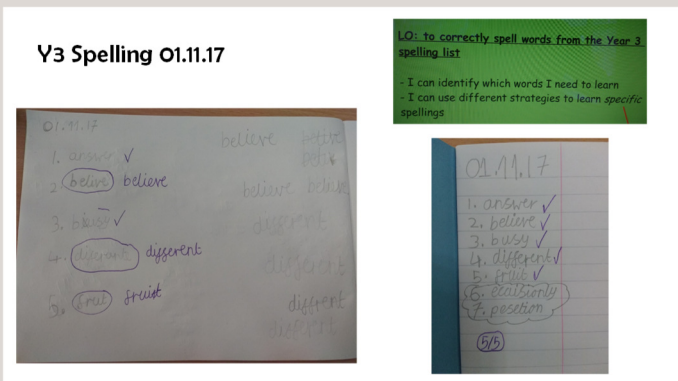
Impact workshops: Y4

The Y4 parent impact workshop was on Wednesday this week and was a real success. Miss McKenzie explained some of the strategies she uses for numeracy with the class and then parents worked with their children practising the strategies.
