Igloos in Reception:

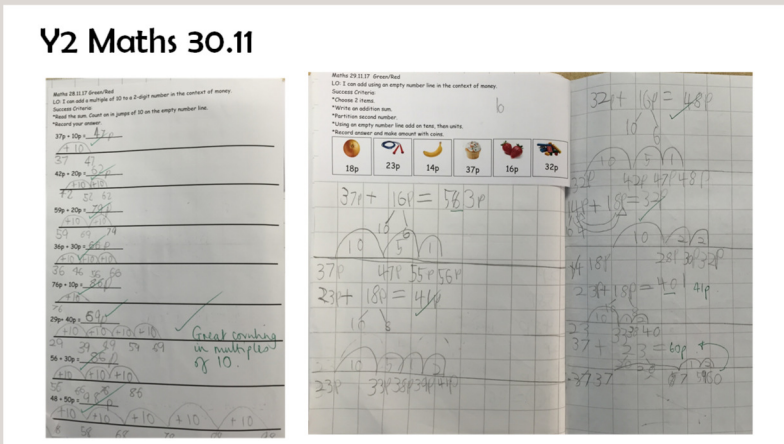
