**School house update:**

Having demolished the school house, the site is currently being cleared ready for the early construction stage. The developers have placed a welfare unit in the car park but is not restricting entry or exit to the site.

**Nasal flu catch up programme:**

NHS nurses are holding a further urgent nasal flu catch up programme this Saturday for children in Reception year 1, 2 3, or 4 that missed their vaccine in school. Flu this year is very serious and local children have been admitted to hospital as a result of influenza. Less than 50% of children in Southwark have had the nasal flu vaccine. This puts many children adults and babies at risk of a serious but preventable virus.


