PE days are Wednesdays and Fridays.



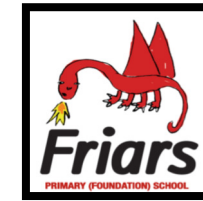

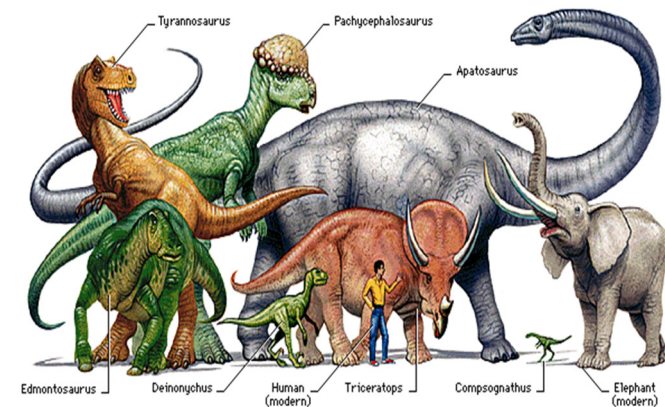
