



Welcome back, hope you had a fun 2 weeks off!

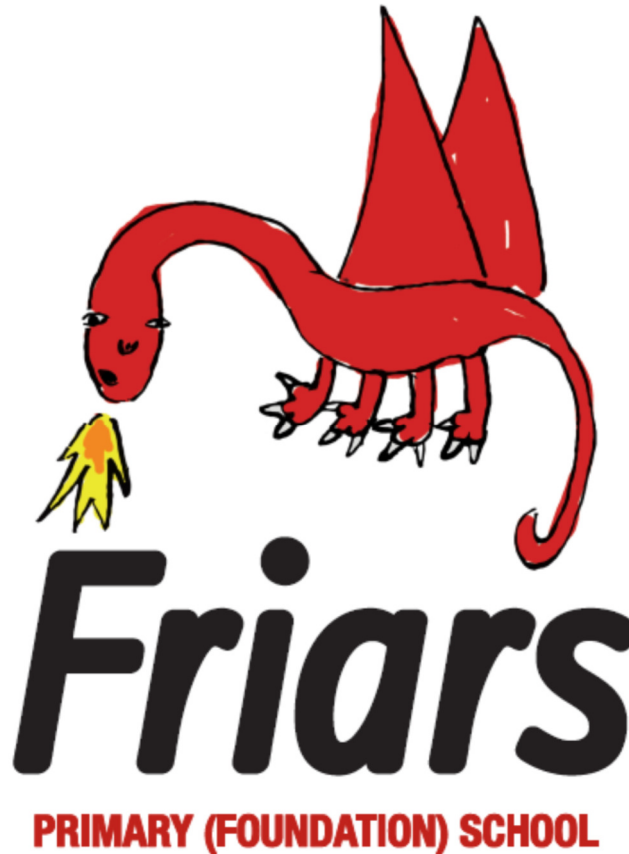
This half term, Year 4 will be studying a brand new topic,
