GDPR:


From May 25th new regulations are being introduced on how schools handle people's data. This is called the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). We will be publicising policies & procedures and notices that are compliant with the new regulations in the coming months. For the time being, your child's data will be handled in the same manner in accordance with legal principles. We have contracted a data protection officer from Judicium education who will be on hand to ensure all data is handled correctly.
