Y5 and 6 Rounders tournament:

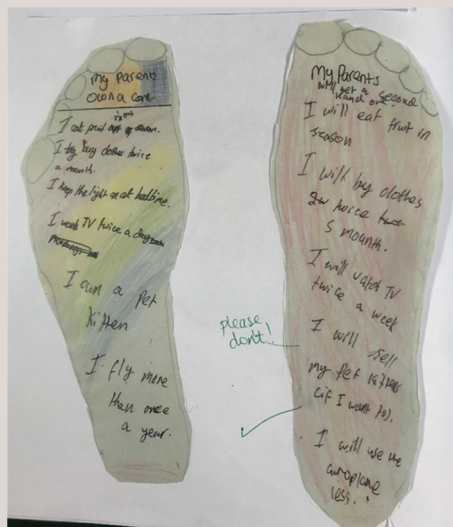
