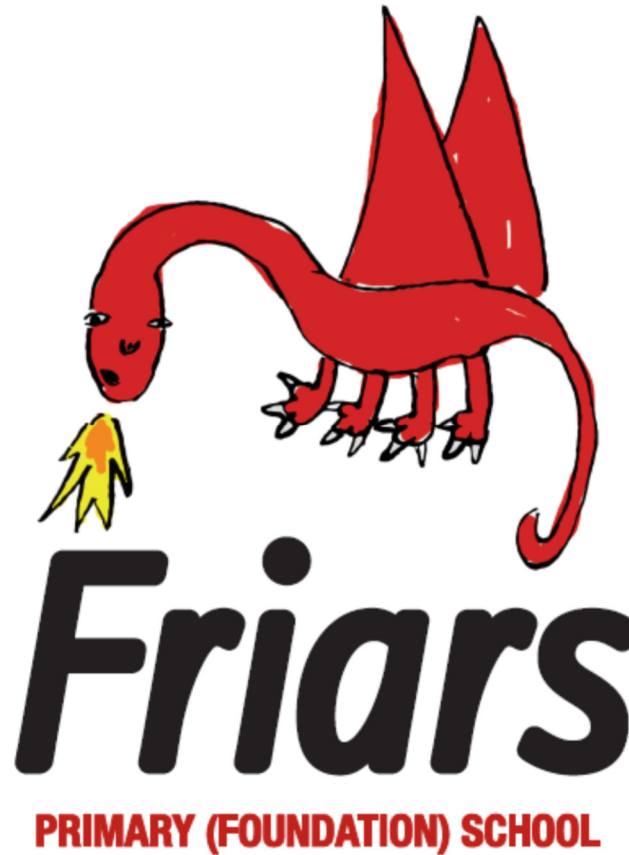
The Year 3 Team
