This term the children will build up their understanding of the chronology of world history and carry out research projects on different aspects of life in Ancient Egypt.


<u>PE</u>: Full PE kits are needed on Wednesdays (Gymnastics with an 'ELMS' coach) and Fridays (Dance with Chantal).
