Online safety:

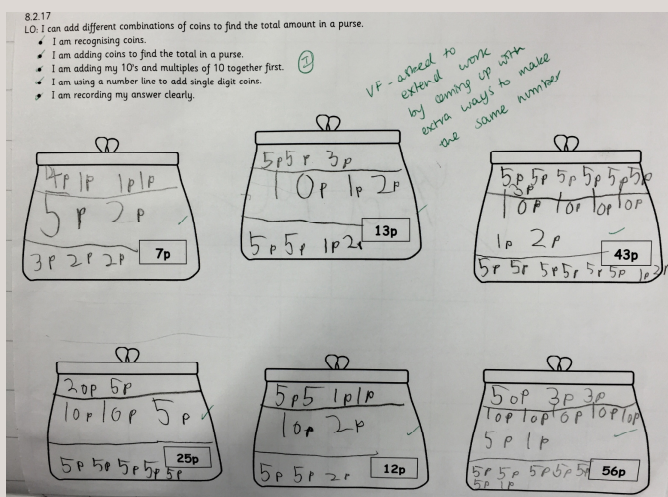
