Eating breakfast on the playground:

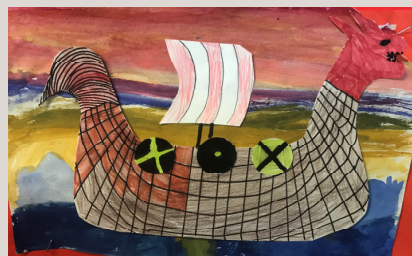
We have noticed several children coming into school eating and drinking this week. This is a gentle reminder that children must eat breakfast at home unless they are registered with our breakfast club.

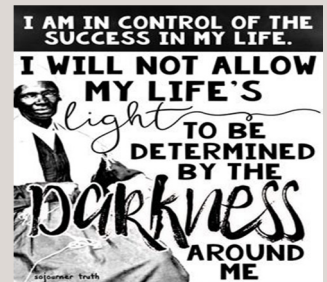
