Kidzania trip:

We reminded all children in assembly today about the Kidzania best attendance trip on April 1st. As always we impressed upon them how important it is for them to be in school.

Upcoming projects to improve children's learning:

Year 2. Three Primary Advisory Teachers from the CLPE on Webber Street are working with children at an early stage of reading in Year 2 for to help them improve.

Year 3 are starting a project called 'Insight Sparks' which is a series of workshops that aim to encourage a better acceptance of others, and to encourage a sense of belonging. It begins around an engaging game called 'Journey to the Land of Fire' and is carried out by psychology researchers and professors.

Year 4 have started working with a professional playwright. With his help they are writing their own short plays which will then be performed onstage at Southwark Playhouse by professional actors. The aim of the project is to support the children's literacy and creativity skills and give them a sense of achievement **Year 5** have enriched their Shakespearian topic by watching 'Twelfth Night' be-

ing performed at the Southwark Playhouse. They are soon due to visit The Globe Theatre to be part of a unique 'sharing' of one of the Globe's ensemble company's shows on *Henry V*.
