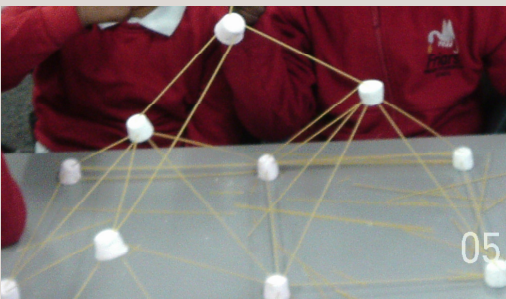
Comic Relief:

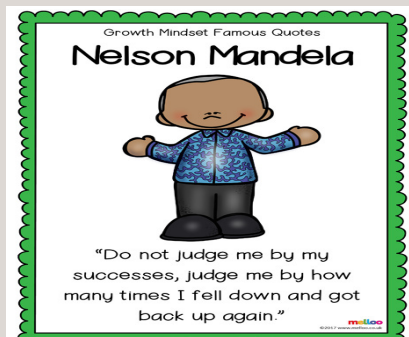
