#### **Dear Parents**

#### **Spring term parent consultations:**

#### **World Book Day:**

On Thursday 7th March we will be celebrating World Book Day. All children are invited to come to school dressed as a character from a book that they have read. We will send home a label for your child to wear, on which they can write the name of their character and the book it is from. Remember, costumes do not need to be costly – there are lots of fantastic ideas for simple homemade outfits online! **Parents are invited to join us at the start of the day (from 9:00 to 9:30) to read with their child in class**. For parents of children in Year Two to Six, you will get the opportunity to see our new 'Accelerated Reader' program in action, which allows children to take quizzes on each book they've read. This program is part of a whole-school push to encourage children to read for pleasure. Research shows that reading brings benefits that help pupils achieve more across the whole curriculum. These include a broad vocabulary, text comprehension, grammar and general knowledge. Reading for pleasure has also been found to be linked to greater progress in spelling and even mathematics skills!

#### **Behaviour:**

This week in assemblies we have been reinforcing our expectations about behaviour. On Monday I explained about how we can all be "radiators" or "drains" (ask your children what it means!) and on Wednesday Miss Foster talked about the importance of rules as a way of ensuring safety. We have also practised lining up at the end of play and lunch times so that all children can show that they are ready to learn.

### Children's learning at Friars:

Last half term, Year 2 learned all about the Great Fire of London. Aside from developing their history, geography, maths and literacy skills, they also did some fantastic artwork depicting the fire as it unfurled!
