STEM week:

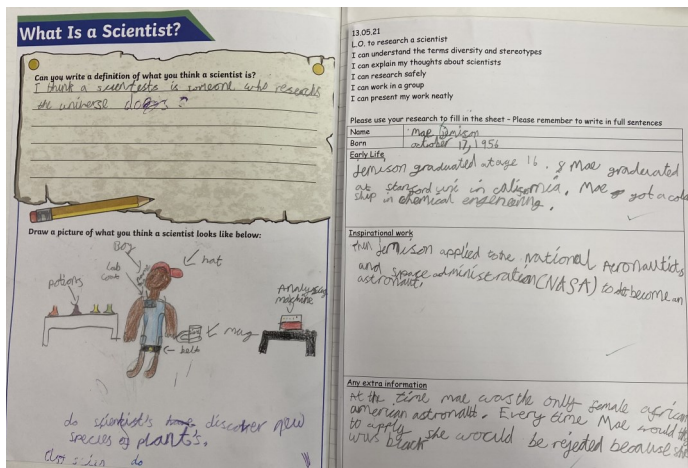
Nursery children had fun being engineers and making a straw roller coaster for a ping pong ball to roll down.



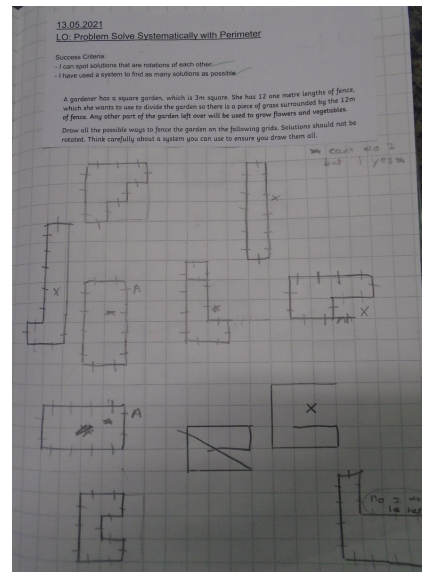
Reception children designed and built a small conveyor belt to transport Lego bricks from one area to another.



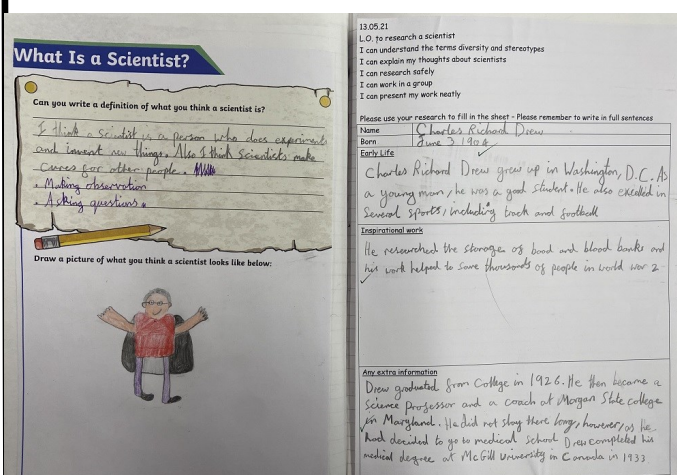
Year 4 thought about what a scientist actually is and they then researched notable scientists from the BAME community.



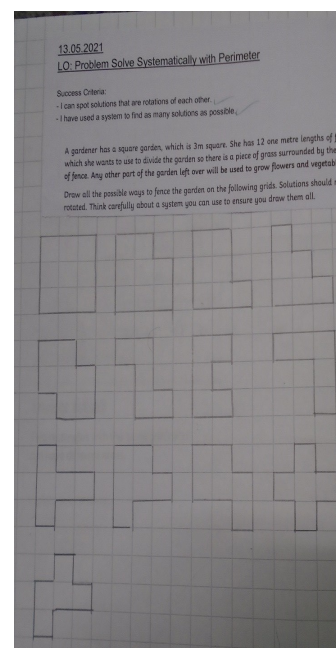
Year 6 had to systematically solve a mathematical problem about how a gardener could use fencing to split her garden up into different areas.
