 - **Discussions involving all members of the school community, not just children**
 - **Themed learning (i.e. health week and wellbeing week, international week, RE focus days etc)**
 - **Enrichment activities both in and out of school with recognised cultural institutions**
 - **Workshops with recognised charities, groups etc**
 - **Considered use of relevant resources throughout all aspects of the national curriculum**
