Children miss lots of learning time through being late.

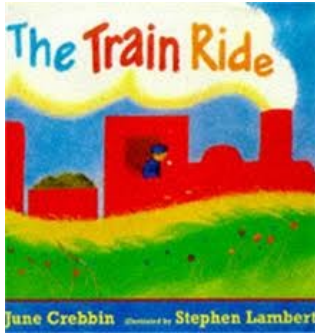

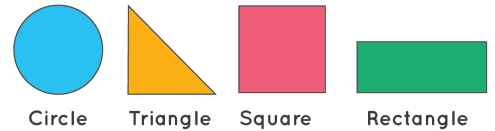

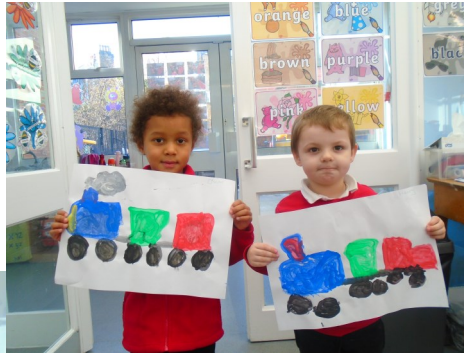
## Nursery

Can you describe these shapes? What is the same/different about a square and rectangle? Can you find some shapes to draw around a make a picture?

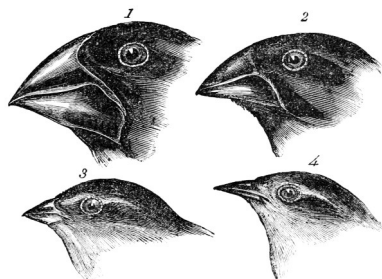


We have enjoyed learning about different types of transport. What is your favourite type of transport?

Inspired by Darwin's finches we investigated other forms of bird adaptation in science. We tested different foot shapes in water and found that webbed feet were best for swimming.

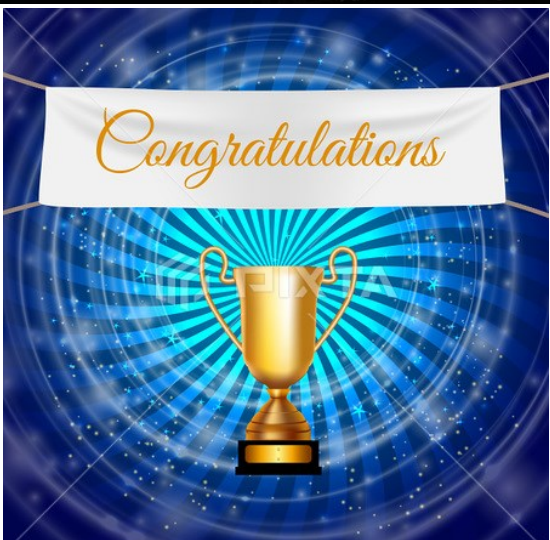
# Sports Leaders Bowling Competition
