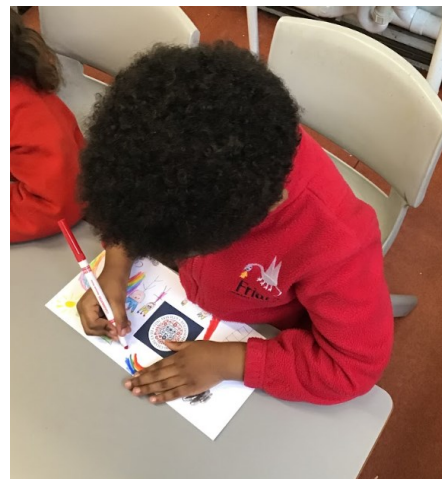
Year One
