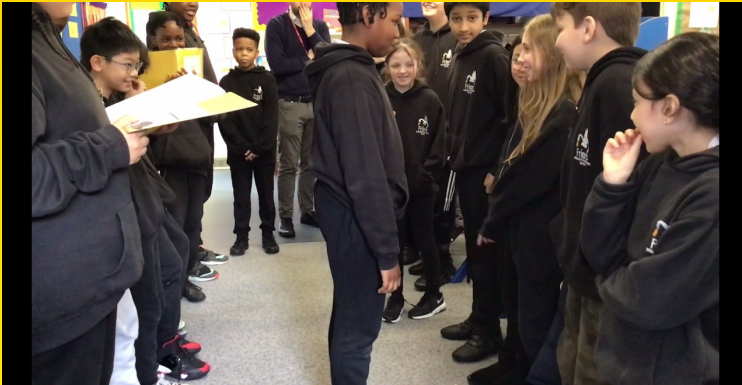






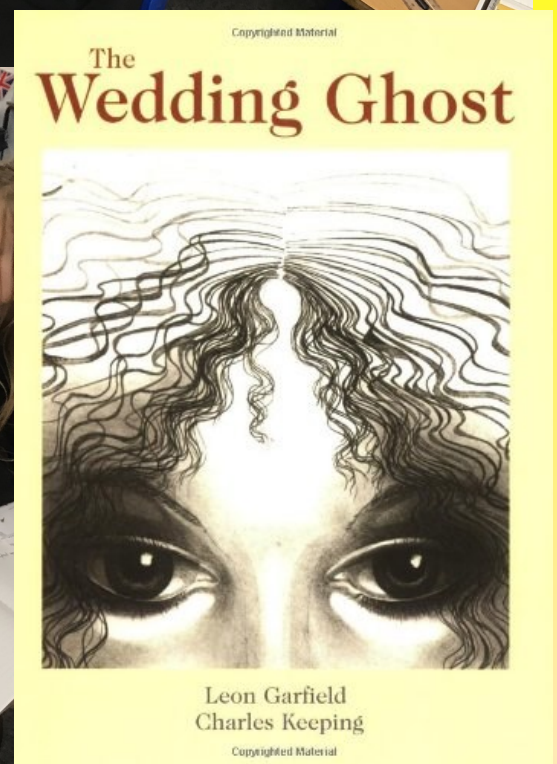
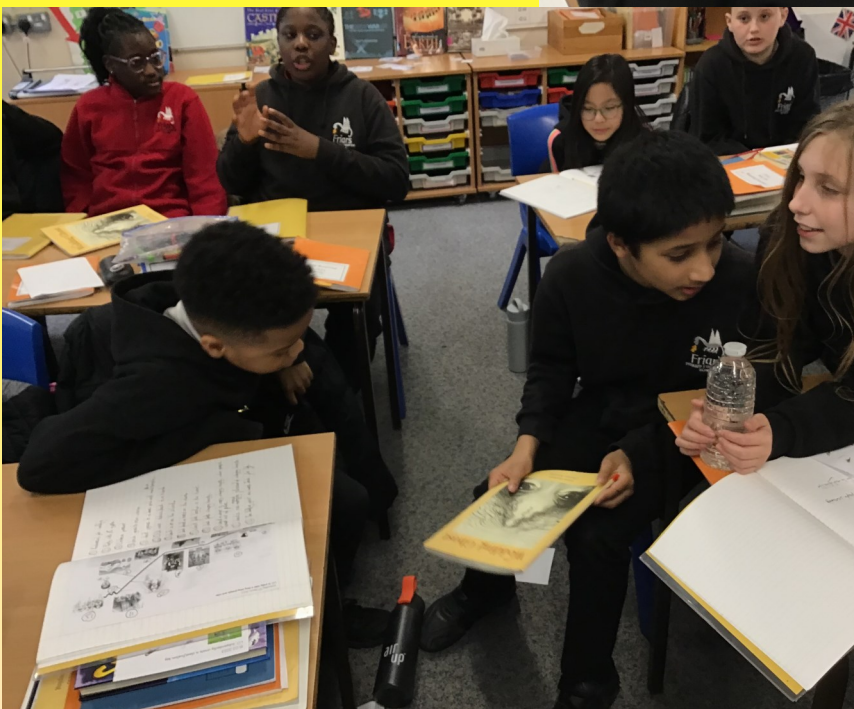


# Year 6 in Spring 2
