# Nursery

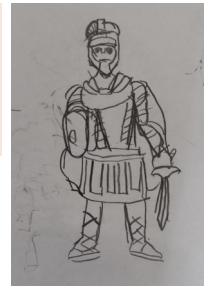
In Nursery we have been learning to subitise. Subitising is when you are able to look at a group of objects and realise how many there are without counting.



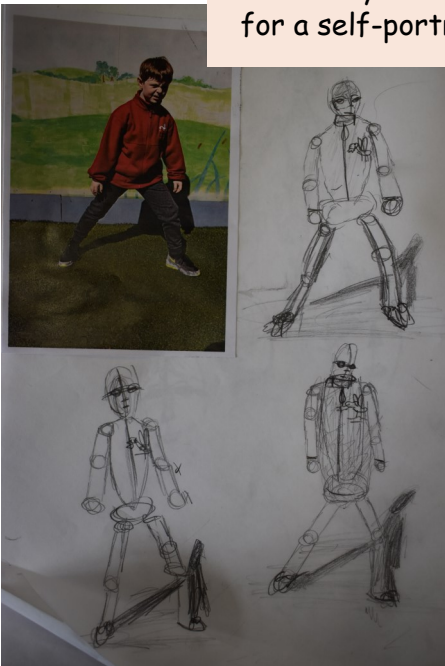
# Year Three

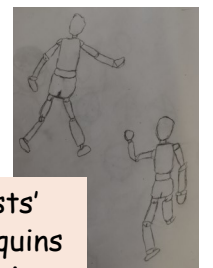
Preliminary sketches for a self-portrait

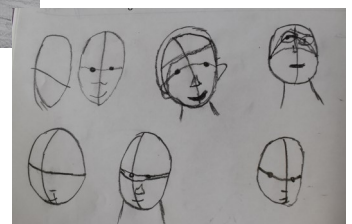
