"The crops need the summer sun for them to grow completely.


### Earthquakes

#### Myths

#### Earthquake facts

1. Earthquakes usually happen on the edge of tectonic plates
2. The strongest ever earthquake was in Chile, in the year 1960
3. Scientists use the Moment Magnitude scale to measure how strong an earthquake is
4. Before an earthquake, fore-shocks might occur
5. After an earthquake, after-shocks are likely to happen
6. Earthquakes occur when the plates get stuck but keep trying to move!
