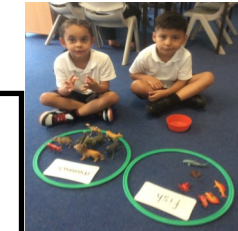

YEAR 1

In History we have been learning about **Kings and Queens**. We discussed the role of the monarch and the kind of **duties** modern monarchs have to do. We worked together in groups to sort pictures of duties into things that **King Charles III** has to do and things that monarchs used to do **a long time ago**. A long time ago, monarchs created rules for the people to follow. We tried being King or Queen for the day and creating some rules which included:

"Be kind to others," and "Look after the environment".

We also held a **knighting ceremony** and honored one pupil a **dame**.



In Science we have been learning about different animals. We learnt that animals can be sorted into 5 different groups. These are **mammals, birds, reptiles, fish and amphibians**. Each group has special characteristics. The children enjoyed sorting the animals in different ways. We learnt that whales, dolphins and seals are actually mammals as they are **warm blooded**, have **live young**, have **hair** on their body and **drink milk** from their mothers.



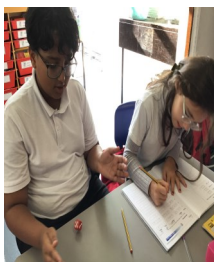
YEAR 5

In maths, we played a thought-provoking game called *Nice or Nasty*. Here are some of our top tips:

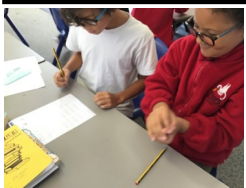
"If you get a six, put it furthest to the left and if you get a low number, put it to the right." (Oscar)

"My top tip is to be Player 2, so you get more chances and beat Player 1." (Daneen)

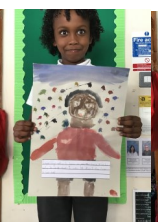
"Play fair and always be supportive. Don't throw the dice in the air because you might lose them. If you roll a six, put it in the thousands column. Have fun!" (Layla)
