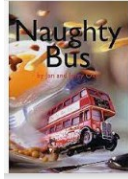

In Maths, we solved simple word problems involving addition and subtraction.



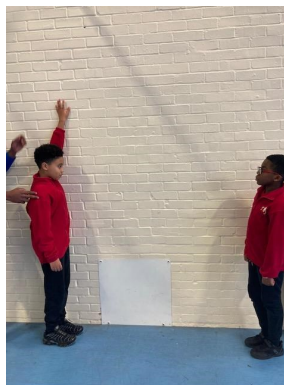
There are 5 people on the bus. 3 more people get on the bus. How many people are on the bus now?
