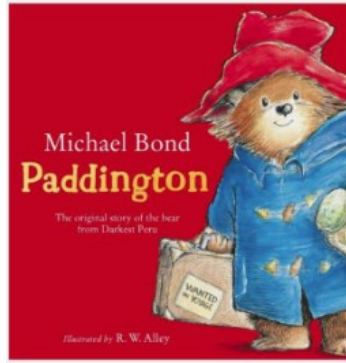

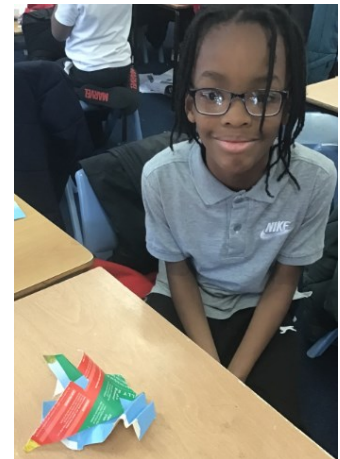
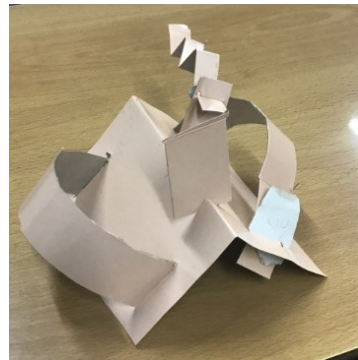
Reception
