They discovered that:

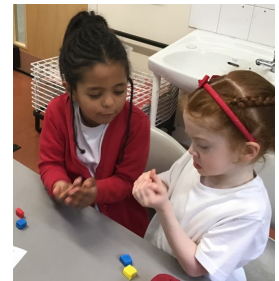
**red** + **yellow** = **orange**

**blue** + **yellow** = **green**



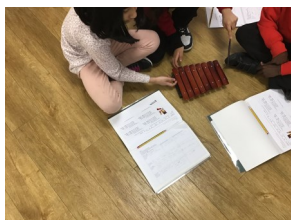
Some children also created wonderful colour wheels as part of their homework project.
